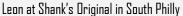

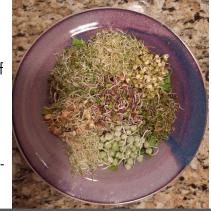
Got Sprouts? by Judith Trojnar, Client Service Manager

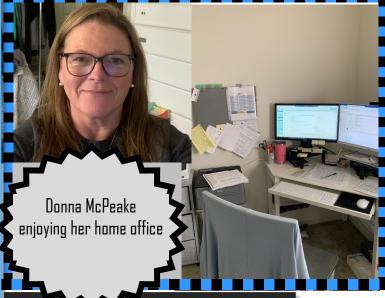

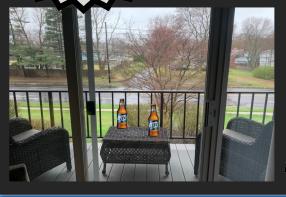


Sprouts clockwise from the top: alfalfa, mung beans, Chinese cabbage, peas, red clover, mixed lentils, broccoli, radish (center)
